Double dose of compact cheerfulness - bright white flowers with brilliant yellow centers along with medium green foliage trimmed with bright golden yellow margins. Prefers warm, full sun, well drained soil. Drought tolerant once established. Attracts bees and butterflies. 12" x 12".
Available later this Fall.

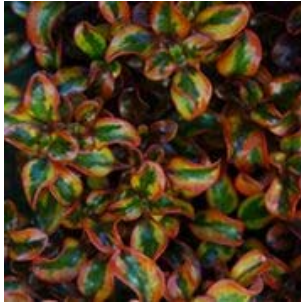


Obsession™ Nandina **Nandina domestica 'Seika' PP#21891**

Unique bright red colored younger foliage is an understatement! Characterized by its upright, compact and dense plant habit, this nandina is an indispensable garden selection. Full sun to part shade.

'Silver Shadow' Compact Astelia **Astelia chathamica x nervosa 'Silver Shadow' PP#2219**

This evergreen clumping perennial looks stunning when paired with darker leafed foliage. Silvery, bold, strappy foliage brightens a container. Can be used as an indoor plant with bright indirect light. 3' x 3'.



Tequila Sunrise

Coprosma 'Tequila Sunrise' PP#189392

This coprosma offers year round interest with its super shiny colorful foliage. Leaves start out green and turn brilliant orange, red and gold tones, intensifying in winter. Prefers regular water, partial to full sun. Use in mass or as an accent in a combo container with succulents. *Stunning!*

'Design-A-Line Burgundy' Cordyline

Cordyline 'Design-a-Line Burgundy' PPAF

Striking, burgundy-colored weeping foliage grows as a dense clump. Exciting choice for a mixed border. Use in a tall container to show off its graceful arching habit.
3' x 3'.



Amistad™ Salvia

Salvia amistad PPAF

Looking for a butterfly and hummingbird magnet? Look no further! Starting early spring these dark purple flowers bloom constantly, which keep the garden alive with visitors. A more compact growing salvia than most of this type. Drought tolerant once established. A true garden performer!
