Sciected for its dwarf, compact habit and shorter, wider leaves as well as its abundance of attractive blue flowers held just above the foliage.

Does not set unsightly seed pods.

Plant along a pathway, group at an entry or use in a mixed container.

Perennial.

Care Information

Follow a regular watering schedule during the first growing seasonto establish a deep, extensive root system. For a neat appearance, remove old flower stalks. Divide clumps every 2 to 3 years in early spring.
